SUBJECT: Registration of Regulated Agent and Known consignor

1. Background.

In compliance with the Proposals of the Committee on Unlawful Interference with the assistance of the Aviation Security Panel (AVSECP), to the ICAO Annex 17 amendments 8,11 13, 14 by 14 November 2014 and Council action, in pursuance of Assembly Resolution A27-7; A 35-9; A36-20; A37-17; A38-15, the following amendments are required.

These amendment include: security control over cargo, courier and express parcels and mail, variations to procedures relating to security programmes and the setup of supply chain security, security for all-cargo operations, security requirements for transfer cargo and high-risk cargo, and establishes common baseline measures for cargo carried on passenger and all-cargo aircraft. As well as new standards on appropriate screening methods for cargo and mail landside security, oversight of external security service providers

2. Purpose.

In order for Suriname to fully implement the ICAO Annex 17 SARP's and the National requirements of the National Civil aviation Program of the Republic of Suriname, Chapter VI paragraph H, CARS Part 13 art.13.4.9 and 13.5, the CASAS is initiating procedures related to application and registration of Regulated Agents(RA) and Known Consignors(KC).
